

Accessibility Services

- Supports students with documented disabilities or health conditions, which may be permanent, persistent, or prolonged.
- Provides academic accommodations to remove barriers to learning. Students are recommended to connect as early as possible.
- Prioritizes the confidentiality of all disability-related information. Relevant information will only be shared with appropriate parties with the student's consent.
- Registration with Accessibility Services is not noted on official transcripts or with the IRCC.
- Students are not required to disclose the nature of their disability to any members of the UCW community.
